AFFIDAVIT OF GERALD M. HANEY

1. My name is Gerald M. Haney and I reside at 10 Central Street, Franklin, New Hampshire
2. I am a retired State employee having retired on or about June 30, 2005.
3. Upon retirement from State service I began receiving a pension benefit from the New Hampshire Retirement System in an amount calculated under the laws and regulations in place and effective at the date of my retirement.
4. I also receive in retirement a health insurance benefit provided by the State under RSA 21-I:30
5. In July 2009 I received notice from the State advising me that my pension check from NHRS would be reduced by either \$65.00 or \$130.00 depending on whether my health insurance plan was a one or two person plan.
6. My pension checks have since been reduced by \$130.00 per month.
